
































FUN WITH KINDHEART

CREATE A MOVIE

Using a smartphone or tablet, have the child film their own short movie with the Kindheart cutout as the star. They can even add special effects and music to make it even more exciting.

PLAY HIDE-AND-SEEK

Hide the superhero cutout in various places around the house or yard and have the child search for it. You can also hide other superhero-themed objects to make it more challenging.

HAVE A HEART



- Life scenarios (see below)
- Music on your phone
- Something that represents kindness (a soft toy, a heart-shaped object, a small pillow, etc.)

Let's play a game that will help us explore some ways to show kindness in everyday life.

Have children sit or stand in a circle. Give one person a heart-shaped object. When the music starts, they will pass it to their right. When the music stops, whoever is holding the heart gets to hear the situation read to them and decide what kindness could look like in that particular scenario. Play until you run out of the scenarios.

If children are enjoying the game and want to keep it going, let them come up with their own scenarios.

- It's cold outside and it's your sister's turn to walk the dog. She has a big test tomorrow and needs every moment to study for it.
- You're playing a video game when you hear that your little brother is crying in his room.
- Your mom has had a rough day at work. She came home extremely tired.
- Older kids at school make fun of your friend.
- Your classmate forgot to bring lunch and has no money to buy something in the cafeteria.
- Your sister wants to watch a movie on the big TV in the living room, but you want to play a video game.
- You notice that your friend on the sports team is sad. When you ask what has happened, she says that her dog passed away.



It's never convenient to be kind. Loving people will always cost you something. It's easier not to love, not to give, not to care, not to share. But each time we miss a chance to be kind, our hearts shrink and become harder.

We are made to receive love and to give love. Each time we choose to be kind, we live out our purpose. We never look more like Jesus than in those times when we show kindness to others.

Explore: Why do you think people became colorful after someone showed them a little bit of love?


